Adam and Eve and the sneaky snake!



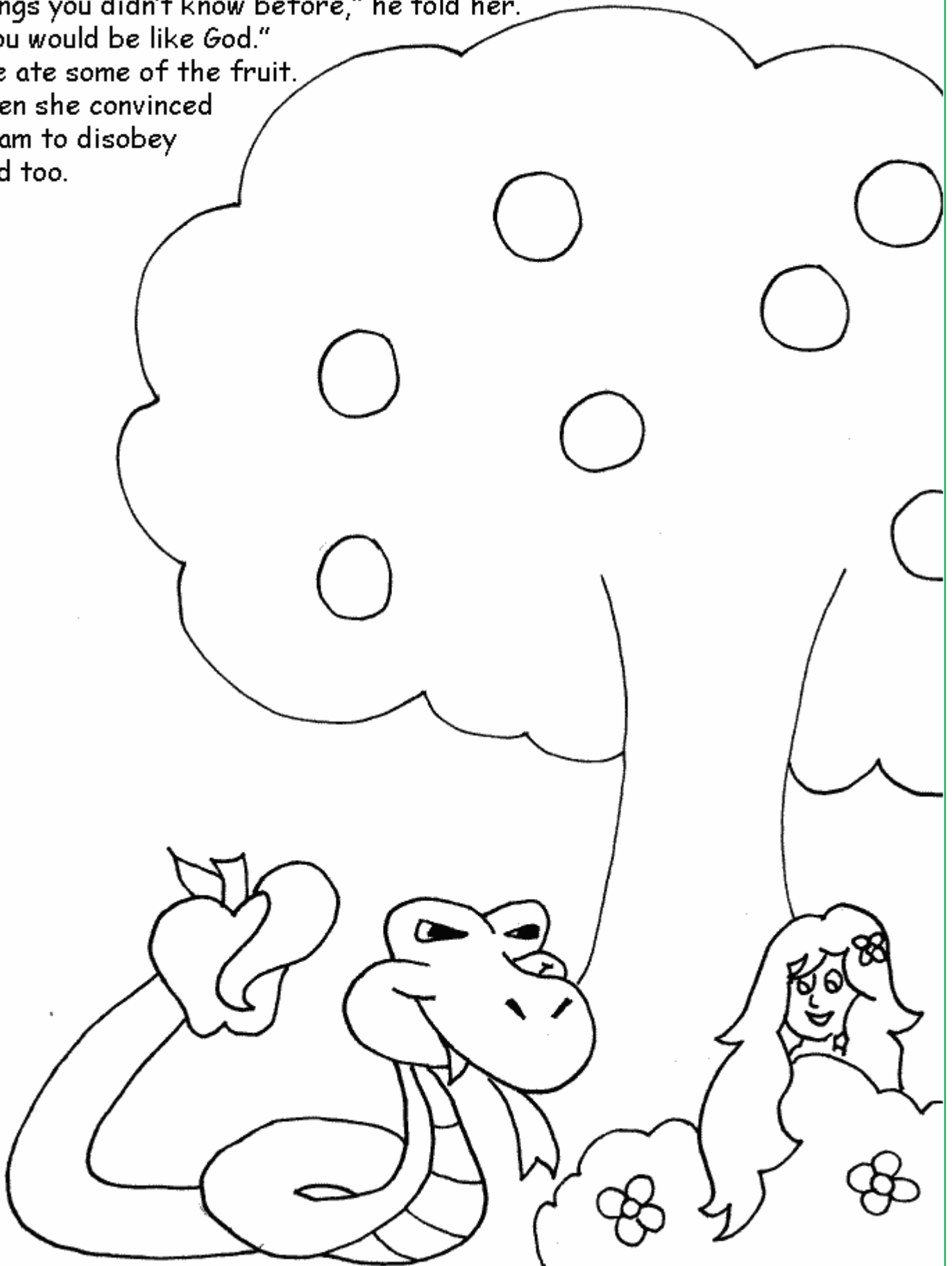
Colour the Picture

"You would be like God."

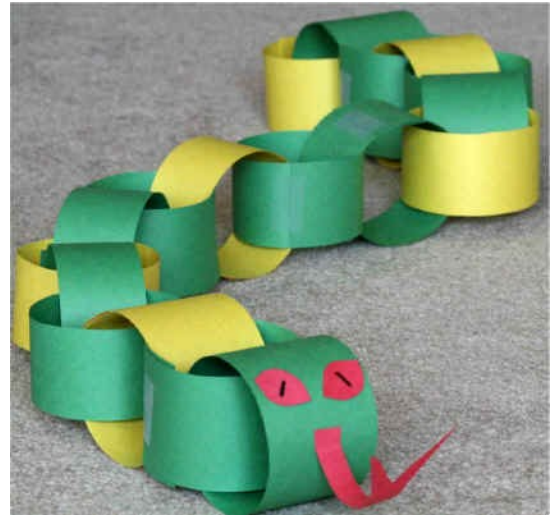
Eve ate some of the fruit.

Paper Chain Snake

This is a fun, simple craft for all ages.



Materials:

- construction paper (2 or 3 colors)
- small scrap of red construction paper
- scissors,
- scotch tape or glue,
- [wiggly eyes](#) (optional) / black marker

Instructions:

- Cut about 16 strips of construction paper 2 inches wide and 10 inches long
- Decide what type of pattern you want to make. We made a green, green, yellow, green, green, yellow... Pattern for ours.
- Make your first strip of construction paper into a ring and tape or glue it together
- Slide your next strip of construction paper through the ring and tape or glue it into a ring
- Repeat the process until you have a long chain of construction paper rings.

Tongue:



- Cut a tongue shape from red construction paper
- Fold a small tab at the end and glue it onto the head (the front construction paper ring)

Eyes:



- Glue on [wiggly eyes](#) or draw eyes on with a marker
- We cut eyes out of red construction paper and drew an eye slit in the middle of each with a black marker
