From the heart

This quarter, our focus at church is shifting slightly from the New Life as expressed in the New Testament by Peter, to how this life was always intended by God, even amidst the brokenness and rebellion of humanity right after the fall in to sin. In other words, we are taking what we know about Jesus and the Christian life, and peering back through history, or 'walking alongside' the persons of historical Israel, as they met, journeyed, grew, wrestled and dwelt with God throughout the course of the Old Testament.

This means that we have to start, of course, at the beginning. But rather than start with Creation, which most of us are very familiar with, we are going to begin with 'the genesis' of Israel as the people of God, starting with the call of Abram. Here was a man, who most likely lived according to the religious traditions of his culture (it is suspected that his father Terah and family worshiped the moon, as many others did in that area at that time), being called by the true God of the universe, to become the father of a new nation, who would serve God and be a blessing to the world. Instead of creating a new person, which God obviously had the capability to do, God saw Abram and chose him from out of the rest of humanity to become His servant. God did not choose Abram because of anything that he had done; his status or wealth, nor even his character. God chose Abram because He was (and still is) God and Abram responded to His call. It was not about Abram's old identity but about his response of faith and acceptance of a new identity.

Abram's response to God's call and obedience to His promises created a new identity for Him (and his descendants) – a new life in relationship with God (personally and corporately). This is the process that all of us have undergone, whether having grown up in the faith or come to it as adults. Our identity in Christ is not defined by our actions, character or standing, but rather by God's grace and our faithful response to His call.

The words "it was credited to him" were written not for [Abram] alone, but also for us, to whom God will credit righteousness—for us who believe in him who raised Jesus our Lord from the dead. He was delivered over to death for our sins and was raised to life for our justification (Romans 4:23-25).

May we all experience this miraculous story of God's call and our response as we study the Word together this term, but may we also experience His-Story in our lives as God continues to call us to respond in faith and live anew!


