


## Esau Sells His Birthright



### 2. Esau didn't think through the long-term consequences of giving away his birthright.

- a. With your parents' permission, you do yard work for some of your neighbors to earn the money a little faster. (Color the squares labeled 2a.)
- b. When the clerk isn't looking, you slip the game into your pocket and run out of the store. (Color the squares labeled 2b.)

### 3. Jacob lied to his father and angered him deeply.

There is a new movie out that your parents said you may not watch. All your friends are going to see the movie. Your friends beg you to go to the movie with them.

- a. You tell them that obeying your parents and pleasing God is more important to you. (Color the squares labeled 3a.)
- b. You tell your parents that you're going to your best friend's house. Then you and your friend go see the movie. (Color the squares labeled 3b.)

#### 4. Jacob stole Esau's blessing and nearly ruined their relationship.

Your sister was very angry with you. She told several of your friends something very embarrassing about you.

- a. You decide that you will not forgive your sister, and you are mean to her for a very long time. (Color the squares labeled 4a.)
- b. You tell your sister that what she said hurt you deeply. You ask her if you can talk about what happened and try to fix the problems between you. (Color the squares labeled 4b.)
